

Mini Scenarios

Overview: Having lived successfully for 45 years with Jehovah Rapha (Ex 15:26) as my Healer, I wanted to share some of the fundamental truths, which I use to live free of the need for man's world of medicine.

A. Tithing.

1. What is tithing?

Webster's definition: To give a tenth part of one's income for the support of the church.

Heb 7:2, 4 Abraham gave a tenth as a tithe.

Neh 10:37 It is a tenth of all that we receive.

Lev 27:32 And concerning the tithe of the herd, or of the flock, [even] of whatsoever passeth under the rod, the tenth shall be holy unto the LORD.

2 Chron 31:5 Tithing includes the first fruit of all we obtain or get.

2. The tithe and God.

Lev 27:28 The tithe is **devoted** unto the Lord.

Lev 27:30 The tithe belongs to God.

Lev 27:32 The tithe is holy.

Heb 7:8 And here men that die receive tithes; but there he [receiveth them], of whom it is witnessed that he liveth.

Mal 3:8 Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, Wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings.

Mal 3:9 Ye [are] cursed with a curse: for ye have robbed me.

3. Lack of tithing looses curses on your life.

Mal 3:9 Ye [are] cursed with a curse: for ye have robbed me.

Gen 3:17-19 Cursed is the ground for your sake.

Gen 4:3 And in process of time it came to pass, that **Cain brought of the fruit of the ground** an offering unto the LORD.

Gen 4:4 And Abel, he also brought of the **firstlings of his flock** and of the fat thereof. And **the LORD had respect unto Abel and to his offering:**

Gen 4:5 But unto Cain and to his offering he had not respect. And Cain was very wroth, and his countenance fell.

Lev 27:28 every devoted (H2764) thing [is] most holy unto the LORD

Jos 6:17 And the city shall be accursed (H2764), [even] it, and all that [are] therein, to the LORD: only Rahab the harlot shall live,

Jos 6:18 And ye, in any wise keep [yourselves] from the accursed thing, lest ye make [yourselves] accursed, when ye take of the accursed thing.

4. Tithing breaks the curses in your life.

Gal 3:13 Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us Note that the Law was given to Moses; tithing was established long before the Law.

Mal 3:10 Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and **prove me** now herewith, **saith the LORD of hosts**, if I will not open you the **windows of heaven**, and pour you out **a blessing**, that [there shall] not [be room] enough [to receive it].

Mal 3:11 And **I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes**, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the LORD of hosts.

Mal 3:12 And all nations shall **call you blessed**: for ye shall be a delightsome land, saith the LORD of hosts.

Mal 3:13 Your words have been stout against me, saith the Lord.

Josh 7:24-26 Obedience to God's directions for tithing brings deliverance. Israel was delivered from the curses of Achan's sins when the devoted/accursed tithe/first offering was removed from the camp.

Achan, his family and all that they had were destroyed.

Gen 14:20 Abraham, the tither, delivered Lot from the captivity of the kings and gave tithe to Melchisedec. (Heb 7:2)

5. Benefits of Tithing.

Mal 3:10 It brings the Windows of Heaven blessing.

Mal 3:11 It makes God a partner in your life. He rebukes the devourer.

Josh 6:17-19; 7:3-5; It brings healing.

Ex 23:25 God takes sicknesses and diseases from us as we serve Him; tithing is serving with obedience.

Mal 3:10, 11 It brings financial blessings.

Mal 3:11 It brings protection for you and your family as He rebukes the devourer.

Mal 3:11 It brings deliverance. (Jos 7:24-26)

The benefits are delayed or blocked by delays in or improper tithing; so tithe as soon as you can after getting income or first fruits.

6. How do you tithe?

Lev 27:30 Treat the tithe as holy.

Deut 26:13-14 Ampl. Confess your sins before you tithe.

Deut 26:14-15 Remind God that He has promised to bless us in this land of milk and honey

Mal 3:10 Bring the tithe to God.

B. Confess your sins.

1Jo 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us [our] sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Rom 6:23 For the wages of sin [is] death; but the gift of God [is] eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Joh 8:31 Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, [then] are ye my disciples indeed;

Joh 8:32 And ye shall know the truth, **and the truth shall make you free.**

Joh 8:33 They answered him, We be Abraham's seed, and were never in bondage to any man: how sayest thou, Ye shall be made free?

Joh 8:34 Jesus answered them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, **Whoever commits sin is the servant of sin.**

C. Forgive others.

Mar 11:23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

Mar 11:24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive [them], and ye shall have [them].

Mar 11:25 And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.

Mar 11:26 **But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.**

D. Mini Scenarios.

1. Be a tither.
2. Confess your sins frequently.
3. Be a loving forgiving person – forgive others.
4. Do affirmations for your healing and health.
5. Receive Communion daily; more frequently if challenged.
