Remember, as a man thinks in his heart, so is he.

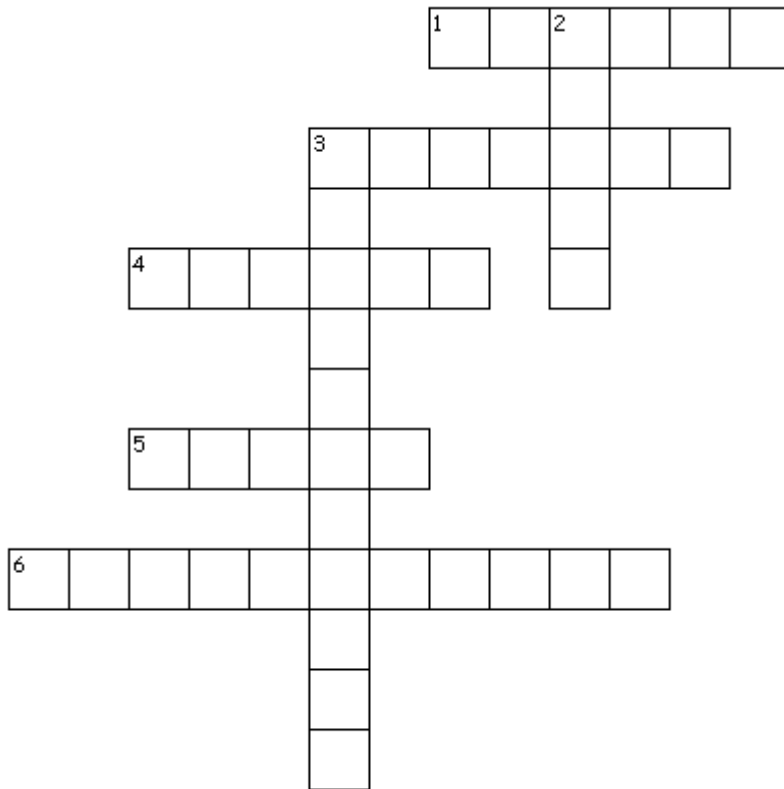
