2. Faith resides in the heart.

3. Out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks.

Matt 12:34

- Mat 12:34 O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? for out of the abundance of the _____ the mouth speaketh.

4. Example of Abraham.

Rom 4:18-21; Heb 6:12-18

- Rom 4:18 Who against hope believed in hope, that he might become the father of many nations, according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be.
- Rom 4:19 And being not weak in faith, he _____ not his own body now dead, when he was about an hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sara's womb:
- Rom 4:20 He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in _____, giving glory to God;
- Rom 4:21 And being _____ persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform.
- Heb 6:12 That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises.
- Heb 6:13 For when God made _____ to Abraham, because he could swear by no greater, he sware by himself,
- Heb 6:14 Saying, Surely blessing I will bless thee, and multiplying I will multiply thee.
- Heb 6:15 And so, after he had patiently endured, he _____ the promise.

- Jas 1:23 For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass:
- Jas 1:24 For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was.
- Jas 1:25 But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and _____ therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be _____ in his deed.

Mark 11:23; Matt 12:34

1. You overcome by the Blood and Testimony.

Rev 12:11

- Rev 12:11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the _____ of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.

2. Releasing angels to work.

Psalms 103:20

- Psa 103:20 Bless the LORD, ye his angels, that excel in strength, that do his commandments, hearkening unto the _____ of his word.

3. You have what you say.

Mark 11:23

- Mar 11:23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have _____ he saith.

4. Taking the land little by little.

Joshua 1:3

- Jos 1:2 Moses my servant is dead; now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, thou, and all this people, unto the land which I do give to them, [even] to the children of Israel.
- Jos 1:3 Every place that the sole of your foot _____ tread upon, that have I _____ unto you, as I said unto Moses.

Note: The verb tense changes from future to past. Healing is already ours for which we see the manifestation when we, by faith (not by sight), walk in it.

5. Signs and wonders follow to confirm the Word.

**Acts 14:3; Acts 8:12-13;
Acts 2:40-43; Acts 4:29-30**

- Act 14:3 Long time therefore abode they _____ boldly in the Lord, which gave testimony unto the word of his grace, and granted signs and wonders to be done by their hands.
- Act 8:12 But when they believed Philip _____ the things concerning the kingdom of God, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women.
- Act 8:13 Then Simon himself believed also: and when he was baptized, he continued with Philip, and wondered, beholding the _____ and signs which were done.
- Act 2:40 And with many other words did he testify and exhort, saying, Save yourselves from this untoward generation.
- Act 2:41 Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added [unto them] about three thousand souls.
- Act 2:42 And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.
- Act 2:43 And fear came upon every soul: and many wonders and signs were done by the apostles.
- Act 4:29 And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may _____ thy word,
- Act 4:30 By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus.

7. Speaking life to those that find them and health to their flesh. Prov 4:22

- Pro 4:20 My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings.
- Pro 4:21 Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart.
- Pro 4:22 For they [are] _____ unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh.

8. Your are justified by the words of your mouth.

Matt 12:37

- Mat 12:37 For by thy words thou shalt be _____, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.

9. Your declarations establish the truth.

Matt 18:16

- Mat 18:16 But if he will not hear thee, then take with thee one or two more, that in the mouth of two or three witnesses every _____ may be established.

10. Releases the Word to fulfill its purpose.

Is 55:11

- Isa 55:11 So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall _____ that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.

11. Your tongue is a tree of life.

Prov 15:4

- Pro 15:4 A wholesome _____ is a tree of life: but perverseness therein is a breach in the spirit.

12. Protecting yourself from the destroyer with your words.

Psalms 17:3,4

- Psa 17:3 Thou hast proved mine heart; thou hast visited [me] in the night; thou hast tried me, [and] shalt find nothing; I am purposed [that] my mouth shall not transgress.
- Psa 17:4 Concerning the works of men, by the word of thy lips I have _____ [me from] the paths of the destroyer.

13. Your words resist the devil.

James 4:7

- Jam 4:6 But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble.
- Jam 4:7 _____ yourselves therefore to God. _____ the devil, and he will _____ from you.
- Jam 4:8 Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse [your] hands, [ye] sinners; and purify [your] hearts, [ye] double minded.

14. Your words silence the avenger.

Psalm 8:2; Matt 21:16

- Psa 8:2 Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings hast thou ordained strength because of thine enemies, that thou mightest _____ the enemy and the avenger.
- Mat 21:16 And said unto him, Hearest thou what these say? And Jesus saith unto them, Yea; have ye never read, Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings thou hast perfected praise?

15. Your words keep you out of snares/troubles.

Prov 6:2; 21:23

- Pro 6:2 Thou art _____ with the words of thy mouth, thou art taken with the words of thy mouth.
- Pro 21:23 Whoso keepeth his mouth and his tongue keepeth his soul from troubles.

16. Your words guide your life.

James 3:2-8

- Jam 3:2 For in many things we offend all. If any man offend not in _____, the same [is] a perfect man, [and] able also to bridle the whole body.
- Jam 3:3 Behold, we put bits in the horses' mouths, that they may obey us; and we turn about their whole body.
- Jam 3:4 Behold also the ships, which though [they be] so great, and [are] driven of fierce winds, yet are they turned about with a very small helm, whithersoever the governor listeth.
- Jam 3:5 Even so the _____ is a little member, and boasteth great things. Behold, how great a matter a little fire kindleth!
- Jam 3:6 And the tongue [is] a fire, a world of iniquity: so is the tongue among our members, that it defileth the whole body, and setteth on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell.
- Jam 3:7 For every kind of beasts, and of birds, and of serpents, and of things in the sea, is tamed, and hath been tamed of mankind:
- Jam 3:8 But the tongue can no man _____; [it is] an unruly evil, full of deadly poison.

Note: Train your tongue with your tongue (Ps 19:14) and the power of the Holy Spirit.

- Jam 1:22 But be ye doers of the word, and not _____ only, deceiving your own selves.

18. Increasing your faith with your affirmations.

Rom 10:17

- Rom 10:17 So then faith [cometh] by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

19. Your affirmations of the Word agree with Jesus.

Matt 18:19

- Mat 18:19 Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be _____ for them of my Father which is in heaven.

20. Your affirmations help you to master a level of receiving before you advance to another level.

2 Cor 3:18

- 2Co 3:18 But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are _____ into the same image from glory to _____, [even] as by the Spirit of the Lord.

21. The Word of God is never vain (useless nor prideful). Matt 6:7; 1 Cor 13:5 AMPC

- Matt 6:7 But when you pray, use not _____ repetitions, as the heathen do; for they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking.
- 1 Cor 13:5 It is not conceited (arrogant and inflated with pride); it is not rude (unmannerly) *and* does not act unbecomingly. Love (God's love in us) does not insist on its own rights *or* its own way, *for* it is not self-seeking; it is not touchy *or* fretful *or* resentful; it takes no account of the evil done to it [it pays no attention to a suffered wrong] AMPC

22. Worshipping God in Truth by singing songs of praise and Worship in which we repeatedly affirm God's Word.

John 4:24

- John 4:24 God [is] a Spirit: and they that _____ him must worship [him] in spirit and in truth.
