The Holy Spirit will never force you because you have been given free will to make your own decisions. He won't force you to open your mouth and speak, but He will provide the guidance for the sound, if you so desire it and have the faith to believe it and act on that faith (i.e., open your mouth and speak and trust the Holy Spirit to do His part). 8.
