- Heb 11:6 Without faith, it is impossible to receive from God.
- Therefore, all promises in the Scriptures must be received by faith.
- So Mark 11:24 is the foundation for acting in faith on all Scriptures.
- The process of praying Mark 11:24 successfully is the foundation for receiving anything from God regardless of the type of prayer that is being used.
- A. Mark 11:24 Petition Prayer.

Petition Prayer is another name we use for the Prayer of Faith, which is Mark 11:24. We pray using the seven Scriptural steps for praying Mark 11:24.

We receive when we pray what the Word says. This means that we meet the three conditions needed for successfully praying Mark 11:24.

The Key: Praying the seven steps and meeting the three conditions.

B. Mark 11:24 Believing that you receive.

The emphasis is on believing that you receive at the point in time when you prayed. It includes Faith Action Plans (FAP) and the Prayer of Affirmations. Words can cancel, or declare, or expedite the manifestation.

The Key: Believing that you received when you said, "Amen".

C. Mark 11:24 Believing you have what you say.

Seeing the prayer of Mark 11:23 as an object of faith through the lens of Mark 11:24, it becomes clear that you have what you say when you said it. It is mandatory to see the prayer answered in the spiritual realm, based on using Mark 11:24. The Prayer of Faith defines when it is done; in other words, you believe that you received when you spoke

The Key: Having faith in your spoken words.

D. Mark 11:24 Believing as a lifestyle.

Apply the principles of faith to everything that we say. Expect to receive when you say something because your words are creative. You have what you say specifically because you have a lifestyle of believing that everything that you say comes to pass.

The Key: Understanding that what you say as a lifestyle affects your prayers.

E. Mark11:22-24. Becoming conformed to the image of Jesus. JTW
Mark 11:24 When you have the God-like kind of faith, you live a lifestyle knowing that
your words are creative Jesus is our example. He had whatever He said.
Mark 11:23 You have what you say. It is a general law and Jesus used it to create Mark
11:24 for us.

The Key: When we pray Mark 11:24, Jesus is our prayer partner and is standing in agreement with us.
