4. Your covenant.	James 4:8; Rom 6:4; Gal 2:20; Rev 3:20

2.	Awake, put on thy strength.	Isa 52:1-2

C. Start Your Day with Prayer

D. Pray Lest You Be Tempted

1.	And lead us not into temptation.	Matt 6:13
2.	Lead me in the paths of righteousness.	Ps 23:3
3.	The Lord will be with you in trouble.	Ps 91:15
4.	Pray that you enter not into temptation.	Matt 26:41; Luke 22:40,46
5.	Pray lest your faith fail.	Luke 22:31,32
6.	Pray that you may be accounted worthy.	Luke 21:36

2.	In every thing, by prayer let your request	Phil 4:6
3.	That your joy may be full.	John 15:7, 11
4.	Ask, believe, behave, announce (ABBA).	Mark 11:24; Rev 12:11
5.	Having done all, stand.	Eph 6:13
6.	Hold fast to the profession of your faith.	Heb 10:23
