

# The Structure of Man Introduction

Overview: Psalm 139:14 states that we are made wonderfully complex. A better understanding of our complexity will help us in every aspect of our walk with the Lord.

### A. Monochotomy

- 1. There is just one entity to man: a body with its parts.
- 2. What you see is what you get.
- 3. If you can't measure it, you can't study it.
- 4. No life after death.
- 5. Hedonistic approach to life.
- 6. Conclusion: Cogito, ergo sum. (I think. Therefore, I am.)

### C. Trichotomy

- 1. There are three entities to man.
- 2. Man is a spirit with a soul and he lives in a body.
- 3. Your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved.4. Man is made in the image of God.5:236en 1:26
- 5. God is (or has) three parts. Matt 28:19; 1 John 5:7
- 6. Conclusion: Soul is the mind, will and emotions.

#### **D.** Pentachotomy

- 1. Man is a spirit being, living in a body.
- 2. He has a heart, soul and mind.
