B) Problems with the Trichotomy

- Spirit/soul/body ignores the heart and mind.
- Using spirit/heart interchangeably creates contradictions.
- Using soul/heart interchangeably creates contradictions.

- The soul is **not** the mind, will and emotions. Heart, soul and mind all have will and emotions and make decisions.
