**The Anointing in You**

**Overview:** The Anointing destroys the yoke by confirming the Word when it is spoken in faith out of a heart of faith. It will destroy the yoke of sickness whenever Healing Scriptures are spoken.

**A. The Anointing and the Word.**

The Anointing is the power of God manifested for a specific purpose. Mark 2:1-12; Luke 5:17

1. The Word does not function by itself.
  - a) The Written Word and the Word in your mind.
  - b) If there is iniquity in your heart. Psalm 66:18
  - c) If your heart condemns you. 1 John 3:20-22
2. The Word works with the Anointing of God.
  - a) Light be; and the Spirit of God moved. Gen 1:2-3
  - b) Let us create man; breathed into man breath of life. Gen 1:26; 2:7
  - c) Confess with your mouth; born of water and Spirit. Rom 10:9; Jn 3:5-6
  - d) The Word was made flesh; Spirit remaining on Him. John 1:14,33; 2:11
  - e) Bind the strong man; Anointing destroys the yoke. Matt 12:29; Is10:27
3. Faith connects the Word with the Anointing.
  - a) Word of Faith is nigh; we began in the Spirit. Rom 10:8; Gal 3:2-3
  - b) As He was teaching, the power was present to heal. Luke 5:17
  - c) Woman (with issue), thy faith has made thee whole. Mark 5:34
  - d) Taught in synagogue but could do no mighty work. Mark 6:2,5-6
  - e) The Word was not mixed with faith. Heb 4:2
  - f) Hearers and not doers deceive themselves. James 1:22
4. The Anointing confirms the spoken Word.
  - a) To whom he showed himself alive after his passion by many infallible proofs, being seen of them forty days, and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God: Act 1:3
  - b) These signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; Mark 16:17
  - c) They went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with and confirming the word with signs following. Mark 16:20

**B. The Glory in you is the Anointing.**

The glory is the manifested presence of God which releases an anointing.

1. All the Power of God is in you.
  - a) Gospel is the power of God unto salvation. Rom 1:16
  - b) The same Spirit Who raised Christ from the dead Rom 8:11
  - c) The anointing abideth in you. 1 John 2:27  
But the anointing which ye have received of him **abideth in you**, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him
  - d) You have enough faith to change anything. Mark 11:22-24
2. You must partner with God to release the Anointing.
  - a) Given us all spiritual blessings; Thy will be done. Eph 1:3; Matt 6:10
  - b) We speak the wisdom of God unto glory. 1 Cor 2:5-7

- c) Much more shall we reign in life. Rom 5:17  
d) The believer overcometh the world. 1 John 5:4-5
3. How much does God want you to partner with Him?  
a) Our Father wants you filled with the fullness of God. Eph 3:19  
b) Know the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints. Eph 1:18  
c) Exceedingly abundantly above all we can ask or think. Eph 3:20  
d) Might be partakers of His divine nature. 2 Peter 1:3-4  
e) Hidden mystery is Christ in you, the hope of glory. Col 1:26-27
4. The Glory in you is available for these Ending Days.  
a) Ready to be revealed in the last time. 1 Peter 1:5  
b) When His glory shall be revealed. 1 Peter 4:13  
c) When He appears, we shall be like Him. 1 John 3:1-3  
d) In Him dwells the fullness of the Godhead. Col 2:9-10  
e) You are gods. Psalm 82:6  
f) If He called them gods and the Scriptures cannot fail. John 10:34-35  
g) Ye in me and I in you. John 14:20  
h) If ye abide in Me and My Words abide in you. John 15:7
- C. The Anointing in you changes you.**  
The Glory of God in your spirit will manifest in you to change you through the anointing as you live in alignment with the Fruit of the Spirit.
1. We are called to be holy.  
a) Be perfect in Jesus. Col 1:28  
b) Be perfect as Your Father is perfect. Matt 5:48  
c) Let us cleanse ourselves .... perfecting holiness. 2 Cor 7:1  
d) Make your calling sure .... if ye do, **ye shall never fall**. 2 Peter 1:5-10 Ampl
2. The Word of God releases the anointing to change you as your entire being (i.e., all parts) is in alignment with the Word of God.  
a) Renew your mind by studying the Word. Rom 12:2  
b) Put the Word in your heart by doing it. James 1:25  
c) Let the Word live in your heart. John 15:7 Ampl  
d) Pleasant words are sweet to the soul, and health to the bones. Pro 16:24  
e) Thou (*i.e., your soul*) are snared with the words of thy mouth. Pro 6:2  
f) Be in alignment: spirit, heart soul, mind and body. Matt 22:37
3. Your tongue speaks the Word to release the anointing.  
a) Out of the abundance of the heart, the mouth speaks. Matt 12:34  
b) The heart teaches the mouth and tongue. Pro 16:23  
c) If you do not bridle your tongue, your religion is in vain. James 1:26  
d) Whosoever keeps his tongue, keeps his soul. Pro 21:23
4. The Anointing changes you, your life and your world.  
a) In His presence is fulness of joy. Ps 16:11  
b) You are kept in perfect peace when your mind is fixed on Him. Isa 26:3  
c) In your patience, you shall possess your soul. Luke 21:19  
d) A wholesome tongue is a tree of life. Pro 15:4  
e) The engrafted Word is able to save your souls. James 1:21  
f) No profit to gain the world and lose your soul. Mark 8:36  
g) He restores my soul. Psalm 23:3  
h) You prosper and are in health even as your soul prospers. 3 John 1:2
