

## Ministering Healing To Unbelievers Exercise

### A) Scriptural Foundations

Unbelievers are not in the Family of God. Therefore, they have no rights to the blessings (Eph 1:3) purchased by Jesus Christ on the cross. The Cup of Blessing (1 Cor 10) does not apply to them until they have received Jesus as Savior and have been washed by the precious Redeeming Blood of the Lamb of God. Specifically, they cannot declare that they have been healed by the Stripes of Jesus (1 Peter 2:24) and have no right to ask to be anointed with oil for healing.

Nevertheless, because God is merciful, He has provided healing at every level for every person. Ministering healing to unbelievers must be done through signs and wonders through the laying on of hands and by the gifts of the Holy Spirit. First the Gospel must be taught to the unbeliever, then the truth of healing declared, and finally an action of faith. All three can be done at once (e.g., Peter with the cripple at the Gate Beautiful of the Temple).

### B) Signs and Wonders

#### Signs Follow to Confirm the Teaching

#### Mark 16:15 – 20

15 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. 17 And **these signs shall follow them that believe**; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. 19 So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God. 20 And they went forth, and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them, and **confirming the word with signs following**. Amen.

#### Faith in the Name of Jesus Plus Action

#### Acts 3:1-9

3:1 Now Peter and John went up together into the temple at the hour of prayer, being the ninth hour. 2 And a certain man lame from his mother's womb was carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the temple which is called Beautiful, to ask alms of them that entered into the temple; 3 Who seeing Peter and John about to go into the temple asked an alms. 4 And Peter, fastening his eyes upon him with John, said, **Look on us**.

5 And he gave heed unto them, **expecting to receive** something of them. 6 Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: **In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth** rise up and walk. 7 **And he took him by the right hand, and lifted him up**: and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength. 8 And he leaping up stood, and walked, and entered with them into the temple, walking, and leaping, and praising God. 9 And all the people saw him walking and praising God:

**Acts 3:12**

12 And when Peter saw it, he answered unto the people, Ye men of Israel, why marvel ye at this? or why look ye so earnestly on us, as though by our own power or holiness we had made this man to walk?

**Acts 3:16**

16 And **his name through faith in his name** hath made this man strong, whom ye see and know: yea, the faith which is by him hath given him this perfect soundness in the presence of you all

**No Deadly Thing Shall Hurt You**

**Acts 28:3-6**

3 And when Paul had gathered a bundle of sticks, and laid them on the fire, there came a viper out of the heat, and fastened on his hand. 4 And when the barbarians saw the venomous beast hang on his hand, they said among themselves, **No doubt this man is a murderer**, whom, though he hath escaped the sea, yet vengeance suffereth not to live.

5 And he shook off the beast into the fire, and felt no harm. 6 Howbeit they looked when he should have swollen, or fallen down dead suddenly: but after they had looked a great while, and **saw no harm come to him, they changed their minds, and said that he was a god.**

**C) Laying on of Hands**

**Mark 5:23** And besought him greatly, saying, My little daughter lieth at the point of death: I pray thee, come and lay thy hands on her, that she may be healed; and she shall live.

**Mark 6:2** And when the sabbath day was come, he began to teach in the synagogue: and many hearing him were astonished, saying, From whence hath this man these things? and what wisdom is this which is given unto him, that even such mighty works are wrought by his hands?

**Mark 6:5** And he could there do no mighty work, save that he laid his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed them. 6 And he marvelled because of their unbelief. And he went round about the villages, teaching.

**Mark 8:23** And he took the blind man by the hand, and led him out of the town; and when he had spit on his eyes, and put his hands upon him, he asked him if he saw ought.

24 And he looked up, and said, I see men as trees, walking. 25 After that he put his hands again upon his eyes, and made him look up: and he was restored, and saw every man clearly.

**Luke 4:40** Now when the sun was setting, all they that had any sick with divers diseases brought them unto him; and he laid his hands on every one of them, and healed them.

**Luke 13:12** And when Jesus saw her, he called her to him, and said unto her, Woman, thou art loosed from thine infirmity. 13 And he laid his hands on her: and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God.

**Luke 13:11** And, behold, there was a woman which had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bowed together, and could in no wise lift up herself. And when Jesus saw her, he called her to him, and said unto her, Woman, thou art loosed from thine infirmity.

13 And he laid his hands on her: and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God.

**Acts 5:12** And by the hands of the apostles were many signs and wonders wrought among the people; (and they were all with one accord in Solomon's porch.

**Acts 8:18** And when Simon saw that through laying on of the apostles' hands the Holy Ghost was given, he offered them money, 19 Saying, Give me also this power, that on whomsoever I lay hands, he may receive the Holy Ghost.

**Acts 14:3** Long time therefore abode they speaking boldly in the Lord, which gave testimony unto the word of his grace, and granted signs and wonders to be done by their hands.

**Acts 19:11** And God wrought special miracles by the hands of Paul:

## **D) Gifts of the Holy Spirit**

### **1 Cor 12:7-12**

7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal.

8 For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit;

9 To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit;

10 To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues:

11 But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, **dividing to every man severally** as he will.

## **E) Ministry Process**

1. Verify that the person does not know Jesus as Savior and Lord.

2. Ask if the person wants to receive Jesus into his/her heart right now.

3. If the person accepts, then:

1) Read John 3:1-8,16 and Romans 10:9,10.

2) Lead the person in the Sinner's Prayer.

3) In the Name of Jesus, speak healing to the person's body and command the sickness/disease to leave.

4) Have the person check to verify that the ailing condition is gone.

5) Tell the person to read the Bible daily and to go to a church which teaches healing.

4. If the person declines, then:

1) Make a bargain that, when Jesus heals the person, he or she will take that as a sign/wonder from God and will accept Jesus as Savior and Lord.

2) Read Mark 16:15 – 20.

3) Lay hands on the person and in the Name of Jesus command the sickness and disease to leave.

4) Have the person check to verify that the ailing condition is gone.

5) The speed, quality and quantity of the healing manifestation will be dependent on the number of times the ministeree has previously been exposed to and rejected the Gospel of Salvation and of Healing.
