

Healing School Semester 2 Summary

Overview: In S2, we learn to receive healing through the Fruit of the Spirit (FOS). This is synonymous with learning to resist the devil by drawing closer to God. Science states that every force has an equal and opposite reaction. This is also true spiritually. Your actions of resisting the devil are the same actions which bring you closer to God. As you walk in the FOS, your soul, health and finances will improve.

A. Lifestyles.

- 1. Confess your sins frequently.
 - a) There are 4 components to sin. Know them.
 - b) 1 John 1:9 Confess (i.e., acknowledge) the sin and repent to restore fellowship with God.
 - c) If you are unaware of sins, ask God to cleanse you of all unrighteousness. (i.e., unknown sins).
 - d) Break curses and cast demons, devils and evil spirits (DDEs) out of your home and your life to address the other 3 components of sin.
- 2. Be a loving forgiving person.
 - a) Mat 22:37-39 Love God and your neighbor as yourself. Mat 22:40 On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.
 - b) 1Jo 4:8 He that loveth not, knoweth not God; for God is love.
 - c) How do you know when you are walking in love?
 - 1) 1Jo 3:14 We know that we have passed from death unto life, because we love the brethren. He that loveth not [his] brother **abideth in death**. Remember that sickness and disease are incipient death.
 - 2) 1Jo 4:20 If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen?
 - 3) 1Jo 4:21 And this commandment have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also.
 - d) Choosing **not** to forgive is not an action of love, it is more an act of hate. Here is how Jesus put it.
 - 1) Mat 18:33 Shouldest not thou also have had compassion on thy fellowservant, even as I had pity on thee?
 - 2) Mat 18:34 And his lord was wroth, and <u>delivered him to the tormentors</u>, till he should pay all that was due unto him.
 - 3) Mat 18:35 <u>So likewise shall my heavenly Father do also unto you</u>, if ye from your hearts forgive not every one his brother their trespasses.
- 3. Keep the Word of God in your mouth.
 - a) Jos 1:8 This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein.
 - b) Tit 3:8 [This is] a faithful saying, and these things I will that thou affirm constantly.
 - c) Mark 11:23 You have what you say.
 - d) Affirm the promises of God in your life.

B. Kingdom Living.

- 1. Establish the Kingdom of God (KOG).
 - a) Living in the KOG is the same as living in Heaven on Earth.
 - b) We can stay in the KOG with its blessing and miracles as long as we do not sin.
 - c) Confess your sins as soon as you recognize them; if no sins, periodically pray, "Lord, I am not aware of any sins; please cleanse me of all unrighteousness."
 - d) Whenever you confess your sins, why not immediately reestablish the KOG?



- 2. The Structure of Man.
 - a) Mat 22:37 The Pentachotomy states that you are a spirit with a soul, and a mind and you live in a body. You interact with the world primarily with your tongue. Your words are creative.
 - b) Ps 91:1 If you are going to stay in the KOG (i.e., dwell in the secret place of the Most High God), then **all parts of your being must remain in holiness.**
 - c) 2 Cor 5:21 You, the spirit, are the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus.
 - d) Let the righteousness of God in your spirit manifest in your flesh as holiness. Rom 6:13 <u>Neither yield ye your members [as] instruments of unrighteousness unto sin</u>: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and <u>your members [as] instruments of righteousness unto God.</u> Rom 6:16 Know ye not, that **to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey;** whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness? Rom 6:19: for as ye have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to iniquity

unto iniquity; even so now <u>yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness.</u> 3. The Fruit of the Spirit (FOS).

Jam 4:8 Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse [your] hands, [ye] sinners; and purify [your] hearts, [ye] double minded.

- a) Gal 5:22-23 The nine parts of the FOS are: (Love, Joy, Peace), (Patience, Gentleness, Goodness), (Faith, Humility, Self-Control).
- b) The first three are more spiritual and primarily affect the heart. The second three are more emotional and primarily affect the soul. The third three are more mental and primarily affect the mind.Note: Faith is heart belief, not mental assent, but the Shield of Faith protects the mind.
- c) As you continue to draw closer to God on any part of the FOS, the corresponding part of your being will be cleansed more and more, becoming more holy.
 Example: As you practice walking in love, your heart is softened by the words and actions of love, resulting in a heart which is more fixed on God and which has more heart-faith power.
- d) If you violate any part of the FOS, then you should immediately confess it as a sin for the violation is moving you farther away from God while at the same time introducing sin, its effects, and its hooks into the corresponding part of your being (e.g., heart, soul and/or mind).
- C. Preparation for Spiritual Warfare (SW).

SW is taught in Healing School Semester 3. Success in Semester 3 depends on how well you learn to live by what you learned in Semester 2. This is because success in all forms of SW in the life of <u>any</u> person is greatly dependent on resisting the DDEs by living in the FOS. If people do not understand this, they end up believing that all their sins & mistakes are due to their own weakness & bad habits. **Jam 4:6** But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resistent the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble.

Psa 25:9 The meek will he guide in judgment: and the meek will he teach his way.

1 Sam 15:22 To obey is better than sacrifice.

Jam 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

- 1. Submit to God.
 - a) Don't do the Don'ts. Avoid sins.
 - b) Do the Do's. Pray affirmations and confess your sins.
 - c) Draw closer to God. See B3 above with James 4:8.



- 2. Resist the devil.
 - a) We resist the devil by resisting temptation. We resist temptation by staying in the KOG.
 - b) We keep our health and we get our healing by closing the door to the enemy, who is here to steal, kill and destroy (John 10:10).We close the door by avoiding sin.
 - c) Jam 1:12 Blessed [is] the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him.

Jam 1:13 Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man:

Jam 1:14 But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed. Jam 1:15 Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death.

3. Cycle of Change.

Everything changes except God. You are going to change. Choose the direction of your change.

- a) Study the Word to renew your mind. Act on the Word to put it in your heart. Speak the Word to set your soul free.
- b) Rom 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your **mind** ...

Jam 1:23 For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass: *Note: hearing and doing puts the Word into your <u>heart</u>. Jam 1:24 For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was.*

Jam 1:25 But whose looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth [therein], he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.

Jam 1:21 Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your **souls**.

c) 2Co 10:4 (For the weapons of our warfare [are] not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)

2Co 10:5 <u>Casting down imaginations (i.e., from your mind</u>), and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

Pro 4:21 Let them (*Word of God*) not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine **<u>heart.</u>** v22 For they [are] <u>life</u> unto those that find them, and <u>health</u> to all their flesh.

Pro 4:23 Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it [are] the issues of life.

Pro 4:24 Put away from thee a forward (*i.e., habitually disobedient*) mouth, and perverse lips put far from thee.

Pro 18:21 <u>Death and life [are] in the power of the **tongue**: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof. <u>Note</u>: *The tongue delivers the* <u>soul</u> Jam 1:21</u>

Pro 15:4 <u>A wholesome tongue [is] a tree of life:</u> but perverseness therein [is] a breach in the spirit.

Suggestion: Partake of your tree of life by speaking God's medicine out of your mouth as you continue to dwell in the KOG
