

## Introduction to H.S. Semester 3

## A. Review.

- 1. Assembling of the Body of Christ (ABC) Church is an Apostolic End-Time Ministry, ordained by God, to teach His people how to be alive and remain until the Son of Man returns. As such, it has major focuses on healing, cleansing, dominion and longevity.
- 2. Healing School.
  - a) Healing School Theme. Jam 4:7 Submit yourself to God, resist the devil and he will flee from you.
  - b) HS Semester 1 Foundations of Divine Healing. <u>Theme</u> - Healing comes through speaking the Word of God. You **submit** yourself to God by being obedient to His Word, not just submitting to the DON'Ts but <u>especially</u> to the DOs (e.g., you have what you say) (Mk 11:23).
  - c) HS Semester 2 Advanced Divine Healing. <u>Theme</u> - Healing comes through the Fruit of the Spirit. You **resist** the devil by living a lifestyle founded on growing in the Fruit of the Spirit.
  - d) Semester 3 Spiritual Warfare in Divine Healing. <u>Theme</u> - Healing comes through personal cleansing. Your body and your home are not meant to be the habitations of devils (Rev 18:2). When you are submitted to God and resist the devil, you can tell the devil to go and he will flee (i.e., run in terror).
- 3. What you should have taken away from the two semesters.
  - a) Semester 1.

The importance of confessing sins frequently. Forgiving from your heart all who have offended you. How to deal with curses Repenting, Renouncing and Breaking (RRB). Affirmations and the power of your words. Healing Methods.

b) Semester 2.

The Pentachotomy – You are the Temple of God

Establishing the Kingdom of God (KOG).

Getting your healing through the Fruit of the Spirit and not relying only on the Gifts. Escalator of the Fruit of the Spirit.

Being a loving, forgiving person.

Stay in the KOG by monitoring your three thermostats of Joy, Peace and Patience. The Cycle of Change.

Two flows of the Anointing.

- B. Healing School Semester 3.
  - 1. Overview.

Begin the process of preparing yourself for the return of Jesus. Learn how to receive your healing manifestation through spiritual warfare. Gain a better understanding of the operations of satan and his DDEs. Draw closer to God by cleansing yourself of the influences of DDEs. Learn how to enforce your God-given authority over the Kingdom of Darkness.



2. Prerequisites for success.

If you have integrated the fundamentals of HS Semester 2 into your lifestyle, then you will have great success in Semester 3. If you have not, there is no time like the present to get started.

Have a habit of frequently confessing your sins during the day. Be a loving, forgiving person.

Stay in the KOG by regularly checking your thermostats of Joy, Peace and Patience.

- Major Topics of Learning in Semester 3. Connection between sin and healing. Connection between sin and demons, devils and evil spirits (DDEs). Difference between DDE's. How to identify sins and recognize DDEs. DDEs are behind your bad habits. How to perform cleansing by casting out DDEs. Class, Line and Group Cleansings. Three Witnesses Prayer.
- C. Preparing for the Ending Days.
  - 1. ABC Preparation.

ABC equips students for success in the Ending Days by teaching them how to live with dominion over their bodies, over sickness/disease, over natural calamities, over DDEs, and over the natural and spiritual kingdoms of the world.

Most importantly, in the Graduate classes, students learn to identify one's own calling in the Ending Days and one's role in preparing for the return of Jesus.

2. Preparing to be alive and to remain true to the Gospel.

1Th 4:17 Then we which are alive [and] remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

**2Th 2:1** Now we beseech you, brethren, by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and [by] our gathering together unto him,

2Th 2:2 That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand.

2Th 2:3 Let no man deceive you by any means: for [that day shall not come], except there come a **falling away first** (i.e., the Great Apostasy), and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;

2Th 2:4 Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, shewing himself that he is God.

3. Preparing to be holy.

Eph 4:24 And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and <u>true holiness</u>.

**Eph 5:26** That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, Eph 5:27 That he might present it to himself a **glorious church**, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be <u>holy and without blemish</u>.

**1John 3:2** Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, <u>we shall be like him;</u> for we shall see him ashe is.

1John 3:3 And every man that hath this hope in him **purifieth himself**, even as he is <u>pure</u>.
