

Seven Levels of Healing for a Believer Exercise

Level 1

Notice the question in James 5:14 below. God does not expect that there be any sick among us. Because of the body and blood of a lamb, there was none feeble among the Israelites when they came out of Egypt (Psa 105:37). How much more should the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ keep you and me without sickness, disease and infirmity! Note that this level requires 3 persons because “elders” is plural. An elder is any person to whom you would go for healing prayer because the person is more knowledgeable or more experienced than you. For situations where a third person is unavailable, by faith use the Lord Jesus as the third person (Matt 18:20).

Level 2

You and your partner can agree that your healing was paid for on the cross 2000 years ago. Once you agree, keep standing in faith until the manifestation shows in your body. If you are asked to agree with someone, it is necessary to agree at the level of the person with the lower faith. For example, don't be praying for a miracle of restoration when the person is believing simply for a successful surgery. Note that this level requires 2 persons.

- Matt 18:19 Again I say unto you, That if _____ of you shall agree on earth as touching _____ that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven.

Level 3

At this level, it is just you and God. Just one person. You arrived here when you realized that God wants you to have every blessing (Eph 1:3), and He wants to bless you with every desire of your heart (Psa 37:4) and answer all your prayers (Rom 8:32). You grow at this level when you realize that Jesus is your prayer partner (Rom 8:34; Heb 7:25); and, based on Mark 11:23-24, He will agree with all your prayers. He did say to you, “Therefore I say unto...”, which is a statement of agreement.

- Mark 11:24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye _____, _____ ye pray, believe that ye _____ [them], and ye shall have [them].
- Rom 10:9 That if thou shalt _____ with thy _____ the Lord Jesus, and shalt _____ in thine _____ that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved (*from sin, sickness, poverty, damnation and hell*).
- Rom 10:10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth _____ is made unto salvation.

Level 4

At this level, you realize that you are the healed of the Lord and the devil is trying to steal the health for which Jesus paid the full price. So there is no need to ask God for healing. It is a done deal; but you need to enforce it in your body and life. Therefore, **you** take your authority and **you** speak to the challenges.

- Mark 11:23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall _____ unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not _____ in his _____, but shall believe that those things which he _____ shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he _____.
- John 14:14 If ye shall _____ (*actually demand*) any thing in my name, I will _____ [it]. (*The sense of the Greek verb "do" is that if He does not have it, He will make it for you.*)

Note: You are not demanding of God but demanding in the name of Jesus and typically demanding of the enemy or of nature (e.g., a mountain or an animal) that which is already yours in Christ Jesus.

- Phi 2:10 That at the _____ of Jesus every _____ should bow, of [things] in heaven, and [things] in earth, and [things] under the earth;

Level 5

At this level, you grow to understand that the devil is a liar and the master of deceits. So, when you look at sickness and disease, you are looking at circumstances. You are looking at the physical world and satan is the god of this world (2 Cor 4:4). So instead of meeting the devil in his arena, you choose to walk by faith and not by sight. You make a decision to go after the demons behind the challenges because the weapons of our warfare are not carnal (2 Cor 10:5) and we wrestle not against flesh and blood (not even your own) but we wrestle against spiritual forces (Eph 6:12).

Level 6

satan is a created being and cannot be in more than one place at a time. So, it is unlikely that he is at any point in time directly behind your challenges. Nevertheless, once you grow to this level, it is often helpful to bind satan himself. A major reason is that we may not know all the demons and evil spirits which are behind the sickness or disease. For example, you may bind the spirit of infirmity but there may also be a spirit of unforgiveness or cancer. When you bind satan, you address them all; if satan is bound, so are all his minions.

Level 7

At this level you realize that any variation from the Fruit of the Spirit is a move away from God's protection and the opening of an access through which the devil may attack you. Walking in the Fruit of the Spirit is remaining in alignment and being submitted under the umbrella of protection of the Blood of Jesus Christ. As the Fruit of the Spirit floods every part of your being, and as Christ lives in all of your heart (Eph 3:17), then the healing anointing of God flows out of your spirit through your heart to deliver your soul and to produce healing in your body.
